At Slaughter and May we're making progress to increase the number of women in our partnership and leadership positions across the firm. We're on course to meet or beat our 10-year partnership target, for women to be a minimum of 40% of promotions by 2027.

At 37.5% we narrowly missed that mark at the five-year point in 2022. Missing targets isn't what we aspire to and I'm confident we can do better.

When I think back to the partnership cohorts around me, women were around 17% of promotions over a five-year window. We've moved a long way since then and we will continue to do so.

We've also made progress elsewhere in the business. 75% of Senior Leaders in Business Services and 48% of our Senior Counsel are women.
